HONOR PASS

The Honor Pass is designed to recognize Senior students for responsible school behavior through the Mukwonago Way.

Criteria

- a. Academic average of 3.00 or higher the previous semester. No grade of F or Incomplete grades*.
*Students receiving Incompletes may apply after they receive a letter grade for the incomplete.
- b. No administrative disciplinary action against the student during the previous quarter or semester.
- c. Students must receive a grade of "O" or "G" in every class for the Attitude/Effort grade.
- d. New students must have been in attendance at Mukwonago High School the entire previous quarter to qualify for the Honor Pass.

Application Procedure

Applications are available in the Associate's Principal's Office and also available online at the Mukwonago School District webpage (under printable forms). Students must return their completed application to the Associate Principals' Office. It is the student's responsibility to apply each semester based upon eligibility.

Privileges

Senior students who have an honor pass will be allowed, during their study hall times, to go to the library without needing a separate pass from the study hall teacher. If eligible they may also have the privilege, with parent permission, of late arrival or early release if the student schedule indicates a period 1 or end-of-day study hall/halls.

Revocation Consequences

Awarded Honor Passes will be revoked if that student receives a disciplinary consequence during the semester in which they have the honor pass (school year) or if any of the following rules listed below are not followed:

1. The Honor Pass/ Student ID must be carried with the student at all times.
2. The Honor Pass must be presented to a staff member upon request.
3. If the student wishes to go to the library during their study hall they must present their Honor Pass upon checking into the library for that study hall period.
4. Seniors granted permission for early release, who leave the building, may not re-enter the building until 2:45 p.m.
5. The Honor Pass will be issued by semester. (Lost Honor Passes will be replaced for a \$5.00 fee.)
6. Honor Passes may not be used to go to the commons or health room.
7. The student does not follow the correct school schedule. It is the **STUDENTS** responsibility to know the school schedule we will be following each day, i.e., Wednesday Schedule, Homeroom Schedule.

Failure to follow these procedures will result in revocation of the Honor Pass.
