The **Behavior Messenger** is not used in the Mukwonago School District at this time.

- Recommendation: No need to check these boxes.

The **Priority Notification Messenger** is not used in the Mukwonago School District at this time.

- Recommendation: No need to check these boxes.

Checking **Teacher Messenger** means you will receive class-related messages sent out from your child's teacher. (Examples: homework info, field trip updates, class news, etc.)

Not all teachers use this tool if they have a teacher website to communicate class info.

- Recommendation: Keep this box checked.

The **General Notification Messenger** sends out messages related to calendar dates, report cards, cancelations, late bus notices, health issues, lunch payments, and other non-emergency issues.

- Recommendation: Keep this box checked.

The **Attendance Messenger** sends messages **based on attendance codes**. At PVMS and MHS, messages go out once a day in the afternoon for any students who still have an **Absence Unknown (AU)** for that day. Elementary schools send out an attendance alert once a day in late morning to notify families of any students who have an **Absence Unknown (AU)** that day.

- Recommendation: Up to guardian to check box(es).
