The district will utilize a community approach to 4K. This method of delivery involves holding the program at community partner sites, which can be daycare centers, private schools, and community organizations. Parents will be responsible for transportation to the site of their choice. The only costs to families will be a registration fee and optional charges associated with wrap-around care before or after the 4K classes at community sites.

The Mukwonago Area School District will offer four-year-old kindergarten during the 2017—2018 school year. Eligible students must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2017.

This will provide an opportunity for all families in the district to enroll their four-year-old in a tuition-free, education-based program that will increase readiness for traditional kindergarten as a five-year-old.

The district will offer half-day sessions that will meet five days per week. Parents will have the ability to choose morning or afternoon sessions.

Regardless of location, the 4K program will be taught by a licensed early childhood/ kindergarten teacher and the curriculum taught will be consistent across sites. The curriculum must be developmentally, individually, and culturally appropriate for four-year olds. Curriculum for four-year-old kindergarten is selected by the district.

Enrollment Procedure:

Registration is completed by contacting the school district office. At that time parents will need to bring a birth certificate and proof of residency to the district office to formally register their child for 4K.

Student registered by the priority registration deadline will have the opportunity to identify the family's preferred provider and will be notified of placement in early spring. Student registered after the priority registration deadline will be given site assignments based on availability.
