Fiscal Responsibility



LOW-TAXING, LOW-SPENDING

- MASD's 30,000+ residents live within 90 square miles across eleven municipalities.
- MASD's eight high performing schools educate nearly 5,000 students.
- The tax levy (total tax dollars MASD asks residents to pay via property taxes) has decreased each of the last five years (6.1%). Of 50+ school districts in SE WI, only three districts can make this claim.
- MASD's tax rate decreased by 39 cents/\$1,000 for the 2015-16 school year (1.79%). At \$8.77/\$1,000, it is the lowest of K-12 school districts in Waukesha County.
- MASD's tax rate is significantly below the state average of \$10.25/\$1,000.
- The MASD shared cost per pupil (\$9,474/student) is the lowest in Waukesha County and is well below the state average of \$10,444/student.
- This year, MASD enrollment increased as state aid decreased by \$616,173. The district is educating more students with less money.
- Due to revenue caps and declining state aid, the MASD school board reduced employee compensation by nearly \$4 million since 2012.
- MASD saved \$3.2 million in building and grounds costs since 2012.
