In *Code Ninjas! 1.0*, students learned that every computer is controlled by **programs**, a set of instructions that direct the computer actions. And behind every program is a person, a **computer programmer**, that creates the code that makes the computer work.

In this four week program, students will continue their exploration of computer science by engaging in further programming using the computer language Kodu. Students will create games and other environments using this intuitive language.

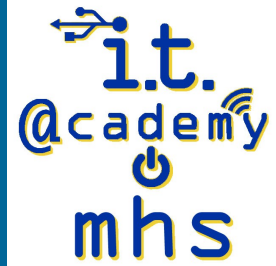
Code Ninjas! 2.0 is open to any student in grades 4-6, whether or not they already participated in the earlier versions of Code Ninjas!
