Park View Middle School has been named a Bronze Wisconsin School Health Award winner from the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction. Receiving this award signifies Park View Middle School's commitment to providing students with the knowledge and skills to make healthy decisions in a safe and supportive school environment that will positively contribute to their academic success.
