The safety and security of students and staff is a top priority at Park View Middle School and throughout the Mukwonago Area School District. Following the tragic event that happened in Florida last week, we want to restate our need for your partnership in keeping our schools and community safe.

It has come to light that with this and other recent tragedies, there have been warning signs on social media. First, I am asking all students to please take a moment to reflect on the trusted adults in your life – parents, other relatives, teachers, coaches and advisors, school counselors, youth pastors, law enforcement and others. Second, I am asking all students to, in a timely manner, talk with a trusted adult if you personally observe or become aware of any online behaviors of concern. This may include bullying, references to self-harm or any threat related to school safety.

It is imperative that everyone understands the serious nature of making threats to school safety – this is never a joking matter in any way, shape or form. There are significant consequences for starting or spreading rumors that threaten the safety of schools. This includes the sharing of threatening social media posts that others have originated.

I am proud to be part of a school and district where students, parents, staff, law enforcement and community members share a common mission of creating safe and supportive school environments. PVMS is filled with dedicated and caring staff and students. We all have a right to work and learn in an environment that is safe and free of threats. Let's continue working together as a team to make PVMS a great school.
