The Park View Middle School Parent Advisory Group is planning a **Student Activity Night** for current 7th and 8th grade students. This event will take place on Friday, April 13, from **6:30 p.m. – 9:30 p.m.** This is a wonderful opportunity for students to enjoy a safe and affordable evening of entertainment with peers!

Admission is \$10.00 with a pre-purchased ticket, or \$15.00 at the door. Students may arrive anytime after 6:15p.m. However, no students will be admitted *after* 8:30 p.m. Advance tickets will be for sale in the health room from 7:00 a.m. – 7:21 a.m. on April 2 – April 6 and in the main lobby at PVMS from 7:00 a.m. – 7:19 a.m. on April 9 – April 13. Students must show their Mustang Pass at the time of ticket purchase. A valid Mustang Pass is required to purchase a ticket and attend this event.

Activities: Students will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of fun activities – 3 on 3 basketball tournament, foosball, Wii Games, X-Box Games, Bingo, DJ Music listening/dancing, Wacky Trikes, inflatables (Bungee Run, Giant Slide, Obstacle Course, and Gladiator Jousting), Props and Photo room, Caricatures and more!

A free coat check will be provided. Coats, jackets, caps, backpacks, purses, or other carry-ins **must** be checked in Room 76. Park View will not be responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items.

Concession items will be available - including pizza, cotton candy, snow cones, chips, popcorn, water, candy & more! A majority of items are priced at \$1.00 per item.

1. Only current 6th, 7th and 8th grade students are allowed to attend this event.
2. Students are not permitted to leave the building prior to the conclusion of the event unless noted on the permission slip and/or a parent enters the building to notify one of the chaperones. Parents are requested to utilize the north entrance.

3. Students may be dropped off at the north entrance after 6:15 p.m. However, no students will be permitted to enter after 8:30 p.m.
4. Students must follow all rules that apply during the regular school day.
5. All attendees are expected to behave in a safe, responsible and respectful manner (i.e., cooperate with all staff/volunteers working the event, use appropriate language, no horseplay, etc.)
6. Students must adhere to the MASD dress code (<http://www.masd.k12.wi.us/district/boardpolicies/5511.pdf>).
7. Laser pointers, blinking lights, lighters, matches, or toys, of any kind will not be permitted.
8. No food or beverages will be allowed out of the cafeteria.
9. No alcoholic beverages, smoking, or drugs will be allowed on school property.

Please make arrangements for your son/daughter to be picked up promptly at 9:30 p.m. If school is cancelled for any reason, F.A.M.E. night will also be cancelled.
